Please note the basic requirements to be eligible for a BCVFA Scholarship are:

- A. Applicant must be a member in good standing of a BCVFA member company and must achieve a minimum of 50 LOSAP points per year to remain eligible for the financial aid.
- B. Applicant must be approved by the President and Chief Officer of their home company
- C. Applicant must be enrolled in, or accepted into, a degree program at a college or university.
- D. Applicant must have and maintain a minimum 2.0 (C) average to eligible.

At this time, we are thrilled to announce that we are prepared to accept applications for scholarships from members of the Companies belonging to the BCVFA. There are 8 - \$1,000.00 Scholarships available for individuals attending college either on a full time or part time basis. There will be \$500.00 allotted for the Fall semester (2023) and \$500.00 for the Spring semester (2024) for each Scholarship awarded.

During the next few weeks, a member of the Scholarship Board will try to visit your Company during a meeting if requested to answer any questions from your membership. We believe that these scholarship funds can be a useful retention tool for the Volunteer Fire Service. We hope that you will discuss this with your members and that you will download the application from the BCVFA website. Please note that anyone that previously was awarded a BCVFA Scholarship can reapply. Each awarded scholarship can only last for 1 year.

Basic Requirements for Scholarships

- A. Applicant must be a member, <u>in good standing</u>, of a BCVFA member company and must achieve a minimum of 50 LOSAP points per year.
- B. Member **must be approved** by the President and the Chief Officer of their home company.
- C. Applicant must be accepted by, or enrolled in a degreed program at a Community College, College or University. This is not intended for one course.
- D. Must **have** and **maintain** a C (2.0) minimum average to be eligible.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Contact any Scholarship Board member for information and assistance as needed.
- 2. Complete the entire application form submit as directed.
- 3. Submit a copy of your latest high school/college transcript.
- 4. Applicant may be interviewed by Board representatives if further information is necessary.
- 5. Applicant will provide proof of enrollment or acceptance into an approved program.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

- 1. Completed applications must be submitted by April 1, 2023.
- 2. Interviews and reference checks completed by May 5, 2023.
- 3. Presentation of Scholarships on May 18, 2023 at the BCVFA meeting.
