FROM: BCVFA SCHOLARSHIP BOARD

At this time, we are thrilled to announce that we are prepared to accept applications for scholarships from members of the Companies belonging to the BCVFA. There will be scholarships available for the Fall Semester of 2024 and for the Spring Semester of 2025 for each approved applicant.

We believe that these scholarship funds can be a useful retention tool for the Volunteer Fire Service. We hope that you will discuss this with your members and that you will download the application from the BCVFA website. Upon request a member of the Scholarship Board can attend a company meeting to answer questions from your membership. Please note previous BCVFA Scholarship awardees can reapply this year if they still meet the basic requirements.

Basic Requirements for Scholarships

- A. Applicant must be a member, **in good standing**, of a BCVFA member company and must achieve a minimum of 50 LOSAP points per year.
- B. Member **must be approved** by the President and the Chief Officer of their home company.
- C. Applicant must be accepted by, or enrolled in a degreed program at a Community College, College or University. This is not intended for one course.
- D. Must **have** and **maintain** a C (2.0) minimum average to be eligible.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Contact any Scholarship Board member for information and assistance as needed.
- 2. Complete the entire application form – submit as directed.
- 3. Submit a copy of your latest high school/college transcript.
- 4. Applicant may be interviewed by Board representatives if further information is necessary.
- 5. Applicant will provide proof of enrollment or acceptance into an approved program.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

- 1. **Completed applications submitted by April 1, 2024.**
- 2. Interviews and reference checks completed by May 2, 2024.
- 3. Presentation of Scholarships on May 16, 2024 at the BCVFA meeting.
